#1 SAFEST CITY IN COLORADO

The seventh annual Safest Cities report released by SafeWise on April 12, 2021, ranked the Town of Frederick as the number one safest city in Colorado. The Town of Frederick takes the top spot, with zero violent crime incidents reported all year and only one property crime incident per 1,000 residents. SafeWise uses national crime data and analyzes safety trends when ranking cities for safety. Several cities and towns in the Carbon Valley and surrounding area are on the top ten list!
