- All photographers will be required to explain why their photograph reflects what matters to them.
- Each photographer can submit up to five photots.
- Photos must be devoid of watermarks, photographer's name/business name, artistic frames, and other added style elements.

The Frederick Police Department has had a substantial increase in auto theft cases and autorelated calls. In 2019 the Frederick Police department took 22 reports for vehicles stolen out of our community. The numbers increased to 39 reports of stolen vehicles and or trailers in 2020. As of July 7, 2021, the FPD has already taken 20 reports of stolen vehicles this year. The statistics tell an alarming story! On Monday, July 19, the Town found blue-green algae in Milavec Lake. The Public Works Department immediately contacted a company to address our concerns. We are taking the recommendation to prohibit all activities related to water contact: fishing, boating, wading, and animals in or near the water.
