FREDERICK'S TOP TEN IN 2021

10. Government Finance Officers Association Distinguished Budget Award

In September, the G.F.O.A. announced that the Town of Frederick received the Distinguished Budget Presentation Award for the Town's 2021 Budget Publication.

9. Via Mobility Services

The Town partnered with Via Mobility Services to provide free local transportation for Frederick seniors (age 60 or better) and people with special abilities. Ride services started in October.

8. Police Department Co-Responder Program

In August, the Frederick Police Department announced a new partnership with North Range Behavioral Health to launch the Carbon Valley & Mead Co-Responder Program.

7. Colorado & Tipple – It's Happening!

In April, the Board of Trustees approved a resolution awarding the design of the Colorado Boulevard and Tipple Parkway Intersection Improvement Project to the firm of Martin/Martin, who started design work in May.

6. Parks, Open Space, and Trails Master Plan

The Board of Trustees adopted the P.O.S.T. Master Plan in January. This plan identifies the recreation needs of today's residents, anticipates those of tomorrow, and provides a framework for creating a vibrant system of parks, open space, and trails.

2022 FREDERICK ELECTION

Are you ready to run for local office? The Town of Frederick will hold a regular municipal election on April 5, 2022. Three trustee positions on the Board of Trustees will be on the ballot for consideration by the registered electors of the Town. Trustee positions serve four-year terms and must meet requirements.

Candidates may pick up nomination petitions at Town Hall (401 Locust St.) beginning Tuesday, January 4, 2022. All nomination petitions are due to the Town Clerk's office no later than Monday, January 24, 2022, at 5:00 pm. No late petitions will be accepted per state statute. So, if you are ready to make an impact on your community, plan on two trips to Town Hall this month to pick up and return your nomination petition!

5. Transportation Master Plan

In February, the Board of Trustees approved a resolution to adopt the Transportation Master Plan. The T.M.P. identifies the Town's existing transportation network's strengths and challenges and sets the vision for the next 10 to 20 years.

4. #1 Safest City in Colorado

The Town of Frederick takes the top spot as the safest city in Colorado, according to the seventh annual Safest Cities report from SafeWise in April. The report uses national crime data and analyzes safety trends when ranking cities for safety.

3. Business Recovery Plan

In January, the Town rolled out the Business Recovery Plan, a grant program to support brick-and-mortar businesses in the Town of Frederick affected by COVID-19 restrictions. The Town allocated \$200,000 in funds to champion a healthy business community.

2. We are FRED

In 2021, all Town staff came together to define our values and culture. FRED stands for Family, Respect, Empower, and Dedicated. We are creating a culture of Family where individuals feel Respected and Empowered by others and are Dedicated to the Town.

1. Strategic Plan

In the summer of 2021, the Board of Trustees adopted a Strategic Plan for the Town of Frederick. The plan has six focus areas with short-term, mid-term, and long-term goals to foster an exceptional and inclusive community that is Built on What Matters.
