



SEPTEMBER MAYOR'S MESSAGE - TOWN OF FREDERICK

Make it a September to remember and welcome back to school, Frederick families.

I know you aren't all excited about the Colorado & Tipple Intersection Improvement construction; we realize there has been an inconvenience here. We are continuing to do our best with delayed timelines and yet-to-arrive supplies. Patience isn't easy, but the result will be a much safer, cleaner, and hospitable intersection for all modes of transportation. To recap the project, The CO Blvd and Tipple Pkwy Improvement project is a major capital project impacting local traffic. Our consultant team provided a recommended transportation improvement project list as part of the TOF's first Transportation Master Plan (TMP). One of the key short-term strategies of the recommendations focused on improved intersection operations and added capacity at priority corridors. As a result, the CO Blvd and Tipple Pkwy intersection is the area of highest need for the Town of Frederick. As the project progresses, lane closures, slowdowns, and a full intersection closure are expected. The Town is working with surrounding businesses and organizations on traffic flow planning during the project. Thank you for not moving cones and signs and for commuting respectfully during this time and beyond. The fall voucher will be redeemable for your one free trip from Saturday, October 1 through Monday, October 31. One voucher per Town of Frederick residence.
