ONE STOP DEVELOPMENT CENTER

In October, the Town of Frederick opened the One Stop Development Center placing all development-related services in one location. The One Stop Development Center is open inside of Town Hall at 401 Locust Street, Monday through Friday, 8 am to 5 pm. Services include:

- Building permits
- Building inspections
- Contractor licensing
- Planning and zoning
- GIS (mapping)
- Economic development

The One Stop Development Center will increase efficiency and improve customer experiences in response to the community's growing needs. While these services remain available online, having a centralized physical presence is critical to ensure consistent service for walk-in traffic. GRANT REPORT

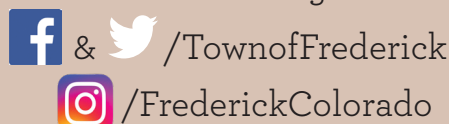
Our new Grant Administrator, Traci Garcia, joined Team FRED this summer, and she has been busy! Traci researches funding sources to submit proposals and documents grant expenses for compliance. In September, the Communications & Engagement department was awarded \$4,000 from the Statewide Internet Portal Authority (SIPA). The funds will be used for professional services to provide managed accessibility monitoring for all Frederick residents, including persons with disabilities, for the Town's website. In October, the Frederick Police Department received notice from the Nineteenth Judicial District Victim Assistance & Law Enforcement (VALE) Board that the Town was awarded \$51,000 for the Victim Assistance Program for the Carbon Valley! Traci's dedication is contributing to the Town's Strategic Plan focus area of Fiscally Responsible Governance.
