Frederick Water Plans-Frederick is dedicated to investing in existing and future transportation, water, stormwater, and technology while planning for sustainable growth and development. The Northern Integrated Supply Project (NISP) is a proposed water supply project coordinated by the Northern Colorado Water Conservancy District (NCWCD) that would create 40,000 acre-feet of new water supplies to 15 water providers. This water is developed by constructing off-stream reservoirs to capture peak river flows without contributing to agricultural dry-up. Frederick is currently a participant in NISP in the amount of 2,600 shares yielding 2,600 acre-feet of high-quality water. As such, the Town recently adopted Resolution 23-R-01, to approve the 19th Interim Agreement to continue participation in this project to provide a dedicated water resource for Frederick's future.

Frederick Reusable Shopping Bags - As you know (if you're like me, you forget this until you already have a cart full of groceries) as of Jan. 1, Colorado businesses are required to charge consumers a 10-cent fee for each plastic and paper bag they carry out of their store. As a Frederick resident, we'd like to help!
