When required: A grading permit shall be required as specified in Appendix J of the International Building Code including the following.

- 1. Two sets of plans showing: vicinity map, property limits, accurate contours, detailed plans of all surface and subsurface drainage devices, finish contours, erosion control plans and details.
- 2. Drainage Report
- 3. Final Geotechnical Report including earthen cut/fill analysis and construction procedure, and over-excavation recommendations and construction procedure.
- 4. Wildlife and environmental assessment report. See Permit Condition 11 below if wildlife or environmental issues have been identified.
- 5. Copy of Construction Stormwater Permit from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (if required).
- 6. Copy of all other applicable Federal and State Permits.
